

TRAVEL RESTRICTION ON NIGERIANS

1. The Federal Government of Nigeria is restricting entry into the country for travelers from the following thirteen countries: **China, France, Germany, Iran, Italy, Japan, Netherlands, Norway, South Korea, Spain, Switzerland, United Kingdom and United States of America.**
2. All persons arriving into Nigeria who might have visited these countries, fourteen days prior to their arrival, will be subjected to supervised self-isolation and testing for 14 days.
3. The travel restrictions are applicable to all flight crew. All operators wishing to operate/ fly into Nigeria are required to operate with two (2) sets of flight crew (augmented crew); one set to operate into Nigeria and the other set to operate out of Nigeria.
4. Effective from 00:00 hours on Sunday, 21st March, 2020, Mallam Aminu Kano International Airport, Kano (DNKN), Akani Ibiam International Airport, Enugu (DNEN) and Port-Harcourt International Airport, Omagwa (DNPO) will be closed to all international flights.
5. Only Nnamdi Azikwe International Airport, Abuja (DNAA) and Murtala Muhammed International Airport, Lagos (DNMM) will be opened to and accept international flights irrespective of the type of operator.
